Notice of Race

1) Date: Friday November 7th– Sunday November 9th, 2008

2) Venue: Wuyuan Bay Xiamen, China

- **3) Organizing committee:** The Chinese Yachting Association, Xiamen Government and J Boats Asia.
- **4) Eligibility:** International sailors will be invited to sail J/80s built and produced in Xiamen, China during this regatta.
- **5) Registration:** Registration and skippers meeting will be held at J World, Wuyuan Bay Xiamen, China November 7th, 2008
- 6) Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) together with, as appropriate, The International J/80 Class Association (IJCA) as amended for this Regatta.
 - * The crew restrictions on weight will not be applicable, crew will be no more than 4 persons per boat regardless of weight.
 - * This notice of race may be amended by the Sailing Instructions.
- 7) International Jury: An international jury may be constituted in accordance with RRS Appendix N. If so constituted, the Jury's decision will be final.
- **8) Advertising:** For boats competing in the regatta is designated as a category C event under ISAF Regulation 20—Advertising code of RRS Appendix A.
- 9) Scoring: The scoring systems for the regatta races will be the low point system.
- **10)Prizes:** The prizes will be awarded for the boats in the first three positions and there will be souvenirs for all boats participating.
- **11)Disclaimer:** Competitors participate in the J World/J Boats 2008 International Invitational Regatta event entirely at their own risk. The sponsors, the organizing authority, officials and staff/assistants will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

Notice of Race

- **12)Boats and Sails:** The Regatta will use new J/80s with a new set of sails provided by J Boats Asia and J World Asia. Boats will be allocated by the Race Committee.
- **13)Rules:** Any contact between boats could be grounds for immediate disqualification of the boats involved in the contact for the race in which the contact occurred. Contact resulting in damage deemed serious by the Race Committee will result in disqualification from the remainder of the event.
- **14)Starting times:** The warning signal for the start of the first race on Saturday and Sunday will not be before 09:00.
- **15)Instructions:** The Sailing instructions will be available at the skippers briefing on Friday November 7th at the J World Facility on Wuyuan Bay.











Press and Media

J World Xiamen and 2008 J Boats Asia International Invitational Regatta will be the first International Regatta held in Xiamen. J World Xiamen and 2008 J Boats Asia International Invitational Regatta will spotlight Xiamen and in particular Wuyuan Bay during the World Ocean Week 2008. The event Organizers will have in place a full media center available for video, print, and web distribution. Press releases will be made on a regular basis from September throughout the entire event. The regatta will feature the first J Boats built in Xiamen sailing on the beautiful Wuyuan Bay.

J Boats Asia purposes to host the '2008 J Boats Asia International Invitational Regatta' during World Ocean Week in Xiamen China. Under the auspices of the Chinese Yachting Association, Xiamen Government and J Boats Asia. International Sailors will be invited to sail J/80s built and produced in Xiamen China during this regatta. Sailors from over 16 countries will be invited to participate. This is the first J/80 International Regatta to be sailed in Asia and will celebrate the production of J/80s built in Xiamen.

It's proposed that this International Regatta will work in unison with the World Ocean Week (WOW) in Xiamen and promote Ecological Responsibility while highlighting Xiamen's marine resources and beauty. The international sailors invited to attend will enjoy the competition and marine cultural activities during WOW. These sailors will return to these native countries with a great appreciation of Xiamen and its beautiful marine life.

The J/80 class attracts a wide range of sailors—in size, weight, gender, and experience level. This is due to the boat's inherent stability (45+% ballast ratio), and simple ease of operation. The 12' long cockpit and high boom enables most crew to pass through the cockpit while tacking or jibing. There is higher premium placed on quickness and coordination than brute strength. The 5:1 mainsheet, 12:1 boom vang, and large primary winches (for jib and spinnaker sheets) further help equalize performance between different strength crews.

The stability of the J/80 allows it to more easily adapt to a wide range of crew weight, without detracting noticeably from optimum performance. Four 15 year olds weighing 270 kilos combined can competitively sail a J/80 around a W-L course in 20 knots and perform all maneuvers. On the extreme side, a J/80 was recently double-handed by two Swedish sailors (one of whom is a class measurer) across the Atlantic Ocean. At the 2007 J/80 World Championships, the Class estimates that most competitors weighed between 60 and 90 kilos.

The age range of participants was from 15 to 70, but averaged in the early to mid 30s. 40% of the boats were sailed with mixed gender, which is considered a high percentage for a performance sport boat championship event.
